MAIN CHARACTERS

ALEX VAUSE

ALEX, PIPER'S FORMER LOVER, IS A SIGNIFICANT PRESENCE IN THE SERIES. HER TUMULTUOUS RELATIONSHIP WITH PIPER ADDS LAYERS TO THE STORYLINE, REVEALING THEMES OF LOVE, BETRAYAL, AND THE CHALLENGES OF SELF-IDENTITY.

RED (GALINA REZNIKOV)

PLAYED BY KATE MULGREW, RED IS THE FORMIDABLE KITCHEN MANAGER OF LITCHFIELD. A FORMER RUSSIAN MOBSTER, SHE EMBODIES STRENGTH AND LEADERSHIP, WHILE ALSO DEMONSTRATING VULNERABILITY AND LOYALTY TO HER FRIENDS.

CRAZY EYES (SUZANNE WARREN)

PORTRAYED BY UZO ADUBA, CRAZY EYES IS ONE OF THE MOST BELOVED CHARACTERS IN THE SERIES. HER QUIRKY PERSONALITY AND HEARTBREAKING BACKSTORY HIGHLIGHT THE STRUGGLES OF MENTAL HEALTH AND THE NEED FOR COMPASSION WITHIN THE PRISON SYSTEM.

OTHER NOTABLE CHARACTERS

SEASON 5
